Letting the Paper Speak: The Art of Katie Smith

Step into a world of quiet strength and vivid imagination as the Plateau Creative Arts Center presents the pastel works of Katie Smith during Gallery Opening Night, Friday, October 3, from 5–7 PM. This is a great opportunity to meet Katie, mingle with local artists, and enjoy light refreshments—including wine and non-alcoholic beverages.

Also on display this month, the main gallery exhibit will showcase the October Members Art Challenge: 4x4

Mosaics. Back by popular demand! Artwork is created on 4"x4" pieces in any medium. These 4x4-inch pieces will be displayed together to create a mosaic artwork.

Finding Grace in Pastels

In a sunlit studio nestled among the trees of Fairfield Glade, artist Katie Smith creates pastel works that speak with quiet strength and vivid imagination. Her upcoming exhibition invites viewers to experience not only the beauty of her art, but the extraordinary journey behind it.

At age 15, Katie's life took an unexpected turn when she suffered a brain stem stroke that left her unable to walk or swallow. A subsequent laryngectomy removed her ability to speak. Years of intensive physical therapy followed, during which Katie gradually regained control of her left arm and hand. It was through this process that she was introduced to pastels—first as a therapeutic tool, and eventually as a creative calling.

Katie's artwork is not copied from life. Each piece emerges from her imagination, shaped by intuition and a quiet dialogue between artist and paper. She lets the paper guide her, responding with color, form, and feeling. The result is a body of work that is deeply personal, emotionally resonant, and entirely original.

Her compositions often reflect nature's serenity, rendered in soft textures and flowing lines. Her studio is a sanctuary where creativity flourishes. Living with her parents in a cozy, independent space within their home, Katie paints in a way that defies conventional boundaries. Her art is unfiltered, unreplicated, and full of quiet power.

Katie holds a degree in art from Kennesaw State University in Georgia. Her influences include Georgia O'Keeffe, whose adventurous interpretation of nature and flowing lines inspire Katie's own style, and Mark Rothko, whose bold use of color invites viewers to not only see the art, but to become part of it.





Turning wood into functional works and pieces of art is the practice of woodturning. Highly decorative Christmas ornaments, bowls, and sculptures are among the many exquisite objects that can be created.

The Cumberland County Woodturners in association with the Plateau Creative Arts Center is offering an opportunity to learn woodturning. Students will complete a safety training course and ongoing training sessions with members of The Cumberland County Woodturners. This training will allow students to utilize the Cumberland Woodturners woodturning facilities at the Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT).

Students can expect to learn how to safely work with wood lathes, and chisels. After successful completion of the safety training students will receive a Certificate that will verify their level of training. And with an additional membership to the Cumberland County Woodturners students will have access to the facilities at the Tennessee College of Applied Technology.

Cumberland County Woodturners members have access to club training programs, supplies, donated wood and ongoing support and mentoring.


